The projects and programs associated with our sustainability targets are all part of our transformation to make our company one of the cleanest and most forward-thinking bakeries in the world. In May 2022, our 10 Woodslea Road facility located in Brampton, Ontario, Canada became the first FGF Brands facility to become TRUE certified. The facility received a Silver level certification for zero waste, with a diversion rate of 93.4%. We are driving waste reduction and diversion at all our facilities through improved data management, team member engagement, reducing waste at the source, and diverting as much waste as we can back into the circular economy. Some key practices and programs implemented at our Woodslea facility include: - Bulk ingredient purchases - Mixed plastic recycling - Innovative label back tape and poly-coated card recycling - Utilizing reusable pallets - Team Member engagement and training "At FGF waste reduction and diversion is just the everyday.
