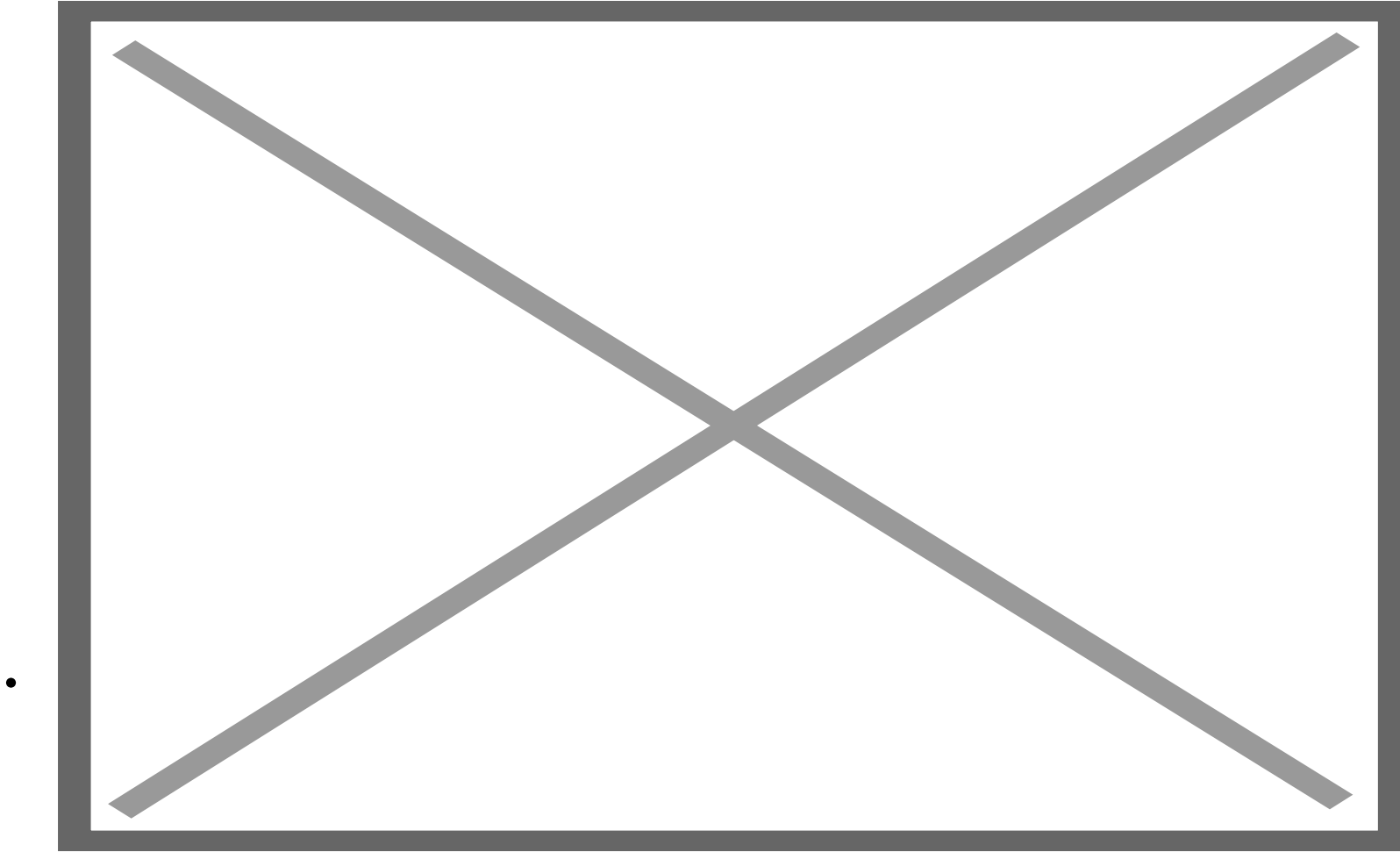

Reuse of pallets, carton crates, tube boxes, and recycling of wastewater sludge as a raw material in the cement industry. This program is continuously driven with a high level of engagement from country and global leadership, and the entire plant team.
