Project Overview

The program improves employee awareness and accuracy by setting up a transparent waste separation display wall in the office to visually display each category of waste. The classification and final destination of each waste is clearly marked on the display wall, so that employees can intuitively see the effect of their waste treatment and enhance the sense of participation.
