Some of the site's zero waste highlights include: - redesigning the waste collection system on site, - using only biodegradable toilet paper, - reducing the amount of paper used in the office by moving from paper-based approvals to an online workflow system, - changing the Consumer Affairs vouchers to the SMS system. Practices such as these divert waste from landfill and incineration, reduce costs, and reinforce a culture of zero waste and sustainability. "By 2025, we aim to achieve 100% TRUE certification for our global operations, including manufacturing sites, technology centres, strategic offices and owned warehouses," says Ann Tracy, Chief Sustainability Officer.
